Product Standards Updates

European standards are written and published by the European Committee for Standardisation (CEN). Once they are published, they must be approved by the European Union. That process is called 'harmonisation'. Once they have been harmonised, they will be listed in the Official Journal of the European Union:

Under the European Regulation on Personal Protective Equipment 2016/425, EU Type Examination Certificates (CE Certificates) have a 5-year validity. When the certificate is issued, product must be to the harmonised standard in place at that time.

For example, if the certificate was issued 2 days before the harmonised standard that is referenced in the Journal of the European Union, then the certificate remains valid for 5 years after the publication of the new standard.

The only time when a product would need to be re-certified to the latest standard immediately is if the previous standard was withdrawn for safety reasons.
